- There is NO POWER to stalls.
- Stallholders will be provided with an advance list of those registered to attend.
- Invite your customers and industry connections as special guests to attend Showcase. (Max 10 people). A personalised invite will be sent.

SETTING UP - FAQ

What time can I set up?

• Set up is from 2:00pm and must be concluded by 4:45pm.

Where can I unload my items?

- · All hand carriable items can come through the main entries.
- Any larger items must be unloaded via the Great Hall Loading dock service lift entrance via Glenelg St.
- A high-vis vest must be worn in the loading dock area.

Where am I setting up?

• The Plaza Terrace Room. Please check-in with a BSB staff member when you arrive and they will direct you to your stall location.

Will there be WIFI?

- To access the free wifi, connect to 'BCECLINK'
- NOTE: There is NO POWER to the stalls. Please make alternative arrangements.

Parking

• BCEC can provide stallholders with a special car parking rate of \$18 using the QR code (see page 6).

Trolleys

· Concierge trolleys can be borrowed from Information Desks, subject to availability.


Access to power

SHOWCASE STALLHOLDER TIPS

Your Preparation - Leading up to the Event

 Determine what message you would like to share at your stall. Set an objective.

Possible objectives:

- Generate sales leads
- Raising brand awareness
- Launch new product/initiative
- Networking
- · Reinforcing company image
- Research/education
- Introducing key/new staff
- Stallholders are allowed to invite guests. Use this opportunity to 'Showcase' your business to your own clients.
- Determine if your message can be communicated in under five minutes. Allow time for your visitor to ask questions.
- Determine who will be manning your stand (and who will be visiting the other stands).
- The staff member who is manning the stand needs to be able to engage people for $1^{1/2}$ hours, often repeating the same message and potentially to more than one organisation at a time.
- Decide on what marketing collateral you will bring.
 Example pop up banner, business cards, laptop or iPad (with own power source) and flyers. All of this will need to fit on your dry bar or table. Please contact BSB to request a dry bar.
- Keep your stall simple and have fun!
- If you are planning to have food samples at your stall, please contact BSB to arrange.

ON THE DAY

To get people moving around the various stalls:

- There will be a 5 minute clock on the big screen to encourage people to move to the next stall. A bell will sound every 5 minutes.
- Attendees will be provided a lanyard upon arrival.
- Each guest that visits your stall will recieve a stamp/ sticker on the lanyard.
- Attendees drop their lanyard in the barrel prior to the end of Showcase to go into the major prize draw.
- There will be 3 prize draws throughout the evening (6pm, 6:30pm and 7pm).

SAFETY AT BCEC

EMERGENCY FIRST AID & MEDICAL

In an emergency situation or if first aid is required, please alert a BCEC staff member immediately. Contact Security on any BCEC fixed phone by pressing '8'.

FOOD SAFETY

If you would like to include food samples at your stall to entice visitors – please contact BSB and we can forward the necessary permit from BCEC. (Note: BCEC requires at least 7 days notice prior to the event).

EVACUATION PROCEDURES

In the case of an emergency in the Centre, please stay calm. Please follow the instructions given by BCEC staff who are fully trained for an emergency situation. Security and Building Services staff are qualified First Aiders.

The Centre has a 2-alarm system, which is as follows:

• 1st alarm sound... BEEP BEEP

This is a stand-by alarm.

Do not evacuate the room but be prepared if evacuation becomes necessary.

2nd alarm sound... WHOOP WHOOP

This is the evacuation alarm, which is followed by a PA message. This message will tell you what level of evacuation is occurring, for example: a room, floor or the whole building. Please use the nearest exit and do not use the lifts in the event of a fire. If we do need to evacuate, all exits are clearly marked with exit written in green. Centre staff will direct you to a Safe Assembly area.

If you have an emergency while in the Centre, dial "8" on one of the BCEC in-house telephones. Let Security know the details/location of the emergency and they will respond.

SAFETY VESTS

All organisers, contractors and exhibitors and their staff must wear safety vests and closed-in shoes whilst on the loading dock, service road.

Vehicle drivers and offsiders or passengers utilising the service road or dock areas who intend to exit their vehicle are required to wear a safety vest or approved hi-visibility clothing for safety purposes.

- 4. Scan the QR code using the QR Code Reader located on the pay station.
- 5. Your discount will be applied, and a \$18 rate will be charged.
